### TASTING NOTES

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We have made a Galician style Albariño since 2001 from 100% estate fruit. This wine exhibits aromas and flavors of fresh apples, pears, citrus, and delicate apple blossom all carried on a frame that skirts the razor's edge between creamy textures and steely minerality. We recommend pairing this wine with fresh seafood over the next 3 years; earlier if you seek crispness, later if you prefer greater complexity.
