TASTING NOTES

When the chance to make a unique wine presents itself one must seize the opportunity and fight to do so against all odds. We literally had to battle large flocks of voraciously hungry birds to harvest what was left of these late harvest Viognier grapes the last week of October.

The slightly botrytised whole clusters were slowly pressed to liberate a thick nectar with aromas of fresh white peach and tropical fruits with hints of toasted almonds. With air, effusive aromatics of pineapple, lemon zest, and raisin prepare your palate for what is to come; a harmonious balance between sweetness, acidity, good minerality and a medley of complex flavors. The stunning finish continues forever.
