TASTING NOTES

The fruit was harvested at peak flavor, fermented cold to preserve its unique aromatics and halted early to capture its own natural sugar and bright acidity at a lower alcohol.

This delicious wine, obviously and uniquely Muscat, combines a great array of flavors from sun ripened peach, Asian pear, orange blossom and honeydew to mango and juicy pineapple. We recommend pairing with selected cheeses, almond biscotti, sponge cake or apple crisp.
