TASTING NOTES

The fruit, a harmonious blend of Muscat Blanc á Petits Grains and Early Muscat, was harvested at peak ripeness. Arresting this cold fermented wine early captured its own natural sugar and bright acidity at a lower alcohol. This sublime wine, obviously and uniquely Muscat, combines a great array of flavors ranging from papaya, Asian pear, orange blossom and honeydew to apricot and candied pineapple. We recommend pairing with spicy Asian foods or a pincho of jamón serrano and melon.
