TASTING NOTES

The beautiful color, fresh aromas, and elegant texture of this rosé are the result of slowly fermenting the free run juice of grapes farmed to make this style of wine. This dry wine entices with aromas of pink grapefruit, dusty cherry, and citrus blossom coupled with flavors of raspberries and strawberries. The finish is crisp with notes of minerality. It pairs well with a variety of traditional tapas, roast chicken or grilled fish.
