TASTING NOTES

The syrah fruit for this vintage stood out for its intense flavors of blackberries, ripe cherries and fresh crushed fruits that mingle with savory meats, smoke, and white pepper aromas. The palate, while very balanced, overlies a rich and structured frame that expands as the lengthy finish progresses. This wine will continue to improve for seven to ten years. Pairings include duck breast confit or roast lamb.
