### TASTING NOTES

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For this cool vintage our hillside vines ripened perfectly producing fruit with intense aromas of black cherries, blackberries, and white pepper. The balanced palate overlies a rich and structured frame that integrates around savory smoked meats. This wine will evolve in your cellar for seven to ten years. Pairings include braised leg of lamb with herbs de Provence.
