TASTING NOTES

The thirteenth release of our flagship Tempranillo continues the tradition of quality and excellence expected from our estate's terroir. The penetrating color and compelling aromas allude to the intensity of flavors that follow. Rich blackberry, savory spice, and well defined tannins unfold on the palate in velvety layers and continue in waves through the long finish. This wine will improve for eight to ten years and offer a long plateau of maturity.
