### TASTING NOTES

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Our "Fiesta" Tempranillo is a fruit forward, early drinking wine made from 100% estate grapes. Careful farming of specific cultivars in West Slope and similar soils enables us to craft this less tannic, high expression wine. Ageing of these fruity lots for 17 months in barrel produced this delicious upon release "fun" Tempranillo. While ideal with tapas such as Manchego and chorizo, it will also pair well with grilled meats. Or just break out a bottle for an instant celebration.
